Qualea parviflora Mart

8 km NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp 12° 54'S. - 51° 52' W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina).

Vernacular name: Pau Terra Roxa.

Shrub; flowering on new growth from a stump
cut back in making a path 8 weeks previously.
The cutting-back probably accounts for the
unseasonable flowering. Petal mauve-purple.

In cerrado on sandy soil with scattered
trees to 10m tall.
