8 km NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52' W, c. 270 km N
of Xavantina).

Vernacular name: Feijão da Arara

Small shrub, 1.5 m tall. Flowers
leathern cream.

Growing in cerrado formation on the
top of a small hill. Soil very pebbly.
Date: 25.6.1968 This species attains 10 m tall in
cerradao but is here dwarfed by the habitat.
