Cariniana rubra Miers

8 km. NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54'S.$ - $51^{\circ} 52' W.$, c. 270 km. N. of Xavantina).

Vernacular name: Cachimbleiro.

Tree, 25 m tall. Trunk 130 cm in girth 1 m above ground level.

Growing in valley forest close to a stream.

The vernac. name (= pipe bearer) refers to the
resemblance of the capsule on its pedicel
to a smoking pipe.  FRUITS
