Terminalia brasiliensis Comb.

Base Camp of the Expedition ( $12^{\circ} 54'S.$  -  $51^{\circ} 52' W$ , c. 270 km. N. of Xavantina on the Xavantina - São Felix road).

Vernacular name: Mirindiba.

Tree, 6 m tall, branched from base into many trunks - largest 11 cm. in diam. at breast height. Bark silvery. Blaze: wood cream; cortex sulphur yellow with a pink stripe at the outside.

Date: 29. 6. 1968 Growing in cerrado formation.
