Heisteria nana Benth.

4 km. N. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp $12^{\circ} 54'S.$ $-51^{\circ} 52' W.$, c. 270 km. N.
of Xavantina). Vernacular name: Mangüê.

Small tree, 5 m tall. Trunk 3 cm in diam.
at breast height. Bark silvery. Blaze: wood
cream; cortex creamy fawn within, mauve at
the very outside. Calyx bright red, persistent
in fruit. Corolla pale green.
