Ouretea crassifolia Engelm.

Close to the Base Camp of the Expedition.

(Base Camp 12° 54'S. - 51° 52' W, c. 270 km N.
of Xavantina on the Xavantina - São Felix road).

Vernacular name: Inharêzinho do Cerrado.

Subshrub to 40 cm tall - presumably growing
from an underground axis.

In cerrado formation on very sandy soil.

The vernac. name Inharêzinho (= little inharê) is
given because it has a serrated leaf margin & therefore
Date: 6.7.1968 resembles the Inharê (*Soroea illicifolia*).

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
