Apiosperma multiflorum A. DC.
Vernacular name: Taiporoca

8 km S of the Base Camp of the Expedition
(Base Camp $12^{\circ}54'S - 51^{\circ}52'W$, c 270 km N of
XAVANTINA).

Tree, 5 m tall. 7.5 cm diam at breast height.
Bark fawn, with deep, longitudinally-elongated, reticulate
fluting. Blaze: cork very thick, fawn-salmon pink in section
; cortex thin, yellow-cream; wood white. No latex in
foliage, only in fruit. Most of the fruits are replaced by
galls.

Date: 10.7.1968 Growing in cerrado at its margin with
grassy campo.
