Tabebuia roseo-alba (Ridl.) Sandw.

Vernacular name: Taiporoca da Mata

Approx. 15° 40' S 52° 20' W

Vale de Sonhos C. 80 km. N of Aragarças  
on the Aragarças - Xavantina Rd.)

Tree, 12 m tall, 25 cm diameter at  
breast height. Bark much fissured. Blaze  
uniform straw colour. Bark charred to  
about 5 m above ground level. Tree  
flowering in leafless condition. Corolla  
white.

Growing in tall semideciduous forest  
on a hillside.
