(approx 290 km NNW of Xavantina)

Vernacular name: ORELHA DE MACACO
Large tree, 20 m tall. Trunk 50 cm diam.
at breast height. Blaze: cork pale yellow;
cortex deep red; wood straw colour.

Flowers dirty - white.

in Tall Evergreen Seasonal Forest.

The vernacular name refers to the
resemblance of the fruits to monkeys'
ears.
