Vernacular name: TANGADA

Near the Base Camp of the 1967-9 Xavantina /
Cachimbo Expedition (12°54'S, 51°52'W, c 270 km N of
XAVANTINA)

Tree, 12 m tall. Trunk 12 cm in diam.
at breast height with small buttresses at
the base. Blaze: cortex red-chocolate; wood
pale straw.

Growing in very swampy gallery forest with
Mauritia flexuosa, Qualea ingens, Qualea
wittrockii, etc. Forest floor a mass of
breathing roots & with pools of standing water.
