Sabicea brasiliensis Wernh.

Fazenda Agua Limpa (University of Brasília field station), near Vargem Bonita, c. 18 km. SSW of Brasília TV tower.

Vernacular name: Sangue de Cristo.

Small shrub with annual shoots to 80 cm.

A grey-white indumentum occurs on the lower surface of the leaves & on stems and flowers. Corolla cream, turning brown with age.

In sparse cerrado at the South of the fazenda.
