Cochlospermum orinocense Steud.

Xavantina (14°44'S, 52°20'W).

Tree, 14 m tall, 80 cm in diam. at breast height. Branching pattern in whorls resembling Cecropia. Bark grey with linear fissures. Flowering in leafless condition. In forest on the top of the banks of the Rio das Mortes.

The specimen consists of only flowers and a few fruits because we were unable to reach any branches.
