Vernacular names: Angajinho (MG), Taxi Branco (MT)

Tree, 13 m tall. Trunk 45 cm in diam at breast height, with silvery bark fissuring longitudinally.

Flowers very strongly scented. Petals & stamens golden.

In gallery forest on the fairly dry top of the bank of the Córrego Capitinga. This species is
