nr HQ (c. 2 km from Macaúba, approx.

10°30'S 50°30' W). Vernacular name: Cascavel

Spring, multi-stemmed shrub to 2.5 m tall.

Growing in a group forming an impenetrable
thicket. All plants in group seem to be ♂.

Bark smooth.

Perianth green. Stamens dirty yellow.

In thicket of cerrado vegetation at the
edge of the airstrip. R.A. de Castro says this is
Date. 18.9.1980 the first time he has seen the species
outside Pará.
