Elaeoluma glabrescens (Mart. & Eichl.) Aubréville

Ilha do Bananal, Parque Nacional do Araguaia (IBDF),
nr HQ (c. 2 km from Macaúba, approx.

10°30'S 50°30' W). Vernacular name: MANGUE

Tree, 15 m tall, 150 cm d.b.h. with
many ascending boughs (multi-trunked).
White latex present in bark. Aerial roots
hanging from crown.

Calyx and corolla pale green.

Growing at the edge of the water of
a small lake between Lago Rufino and the Rio
Araguaia in a place flooded to
many metres during the rainy season.
