Gochnatia polymorpha DC.

Vernacular name: Cambará-acu.

Floresta de Angatuba (23°27'S 48°25'W),
Instituto Florestal de SP.

In scrubby secondary vegetation.

Weed tree, 6 m tall. Trunk 35 cm diam. at base from which it gives off many ascending branches (Buddleia-like form). Bark deeply fissured in a vertically stretched reticulate pattern (almost fluted). Flowers pale yellowish cream.
