In a fire-break (aceiro) between a pine plantation and the cerrado reserve, growing with many other low species, eg Parinari, etc.

Subshrub, occurring in patches, stemless or with stems to 8 cm. Corolla deep wine-coloured. Stamens 5, antipetalous. Flowers with a strong scent of bananas with a hint of durian. White latex in leaf-base.
