Vernacular name: Caneleira

Fazenda Nhumirim (Pantanal subregion of Nhecolândia), 19°14'S 57°01'W, c. 100 km SE of Corumbá, alt. c. 89 m.

Cerrado on a strip of slightly elevated ground at the edge of a grassy campo.

Small tree, 5 m tall, 18 cm d.b.h., with bark fissured into a longitudinally running brickwall-like pattern.

Receptacular cups of fruits turning pink on aging.
