Calycophyllum multiflorum Griseb.

Vernacular name: Castello.

Corumbá, MS, 19°01'S 57°39'W.

In remains of chaco forest close to the city (roadside in area of the Fazenda of Dr Romeu).

Tree, 9 m tall, 25 cm d.b.h., with straight trunk and rather spruce (Picea)-like branching pattern. Bark fissured in regular longitudinal pattern somewhat like Landim (Calophyllum brasiliense) but with the fissures much closer. Provides excellent timber.
