Goldmania paraguensis (Benth.) Brennan

Area of Fazenda Acurizal (headquarters  
19°38'S 57°10'W).

By the roadside.

Multi-trunked tree, 6 m tall. Bark  
smooth. Cut stems, crushed leaves, etc  
with nauseous garlic-like smell (hence  
vernacular name). Flowers pale  
yellow-green, filaments white.

Vernacular name: Pau de alho.
