Campomanesia guariroba

Serra de Itapiraçaba, c. 12km from
Januária (15° 29'S 44° 22'W) on the
Pandeiros road.

In low forest at the base of limestone
cliffs.

Slender tree, 8m tall with 3 trunks almost
from the base, thickest 8cm dbh. Trunk
lobed at base. Bark fawn, papery,
detaching in longitudinal scales. Very
floriferous. Petals white, stamens pale
cream. Flowers with mixed sweet and
disinfectant scent - said to be like
jambo.
