Neoglazovia variegata (Arruda de Camara) Mez

Serra de Itapiraçaba, c. 12km from
Januária (15° 29' S 44° 22' W) on the
Pandeiros road.

In the shade of deciduous forest on
calcareous soil in a place where there is
much outcropping limestone.

Ground bromeliad. Leaves to 1.5m,
olive-green with pale bands.
Inflorescences to 80cm. Young fruits pale
pink.
