*Gaylussacia brasiliensis* (Spr.) Meissn.

Parque Nacional de Brasília (HQ Buildings 15°44'S 47°55'W), stream running into the Cabeceira of the Córrego Barrigudo.

Growing out of the rapidly running clear water of the stream, in a low, narrow gallery.

Slender, erect, many-stemmed shrub, 3m tall. Corollas scarlet. Ripe fruits black.
