2.3km from highway BR262 on the unfinished road MS 454 (about 50km from Corumbá).

Roadside vegetation in an area of true chaco.

Wide-crowned, thick-trunked shrub, 2.5m tall. Filaments pale mauve-white. This species grows into a tree and there is a 4m tree nearby with dark fawn bark fissured and scaling in a vertically elongated reticulate pattern. Many trees of Machaerium hirtum are in the locality.
