Vernacular name:

c. 14km from BR262 on the Estrada Maria Coelho, Morro São Domingo, near the entrance to the Sítio Nismat (c. 35km from Corumbá).

Liana climbing along a roadside fence.

Corolla waxy mauve-purple, very fleshy, closed but separating into two valves (presumably by the action of a heavy pollinator). Corollas yellow in bud and turning waxy pale pink when senescent. Pollinators seem to be carpenter bees which are flying around the flowers.
