

FLORA OF BELIZE

Vernacular name:

Belize District. Gale's Point (sea to Bar River), just south of Bar River mouth, Transect 1, c. 17°14'N 88°18'W

In a scrubby area of coconut palms and *Imperata* grass close to the sea.

Large amaryllid with inflorescences to 65 cm tall. Flowers white with green filaments and yellow-brown dehisced anthers.
