Rhabdadenia biflora (Jacq.) Muell.-Arg.

Vernacular name:

Belize District. Gale's Point (sea to Bar River), just south of Bar River mouth, Transect 1, c. 17°14'N 88°18'W

On the margin of an island of black and white mangroves surrounded by grassy campo.

Subshrub to 70 cm tall. Corolla white with yellow throat. Latex white.
