

FLORA OF BELIZE

Hampea trilobata Standl.

Vernacular name:

Belize District. Gale's Point (sea to Quashie Trap lagoon) seaward end, c. 2 km S of Bar River mouth, Transect 2, c. 17°13'N 88°18'W.

At the seaward edge of thicket vegetation just behind a grove of coconut palms along the beach.

Windblown shrub, 4m tall. Found as a tree to 6 m tall in more sheltered localities.
