No. R. 6694 Mouriri pusa Gardner Vernacular names: Pusá, Croada Transect area, Fazenda Madeira, 7°11'S 47°25'W, approximately 17km N of Carolina. In cerrado on very sandy soil. Twin-trunked tree, 8m tall with the thicker trunk 30 cm dbh. Bark very deeply fissured into vertical ridges to 4cm deep. Cauliflorous with flowers massed along the branches and boughs. Petals waxy cream. The vernacular 'Croada' seems to be a contraction of 'Coroa de frade', the name given to M. elliptica because of the abcission scar at the top of the fruit, and its use for this smooth-fruited species is probably the result of popular taxonomic confusion!
