## FLORA OF BRAZIL State of Maranhão

No. R. 6698 Mouriri elliptica Mart. Vernacular name: Coroa de Frade Transect area, Fazenda Madeira, 7°11'S 47°25'W, approximately 17km N of Carolina. Rather open campo cerrado on very sandy soil. Shrub, 4m tall with a widely branched form; middle and largest trunk 12cm dbh. Bark grey, scaling in a fairly regular, vertically elongate reticulum. Flowers with creamy white sepals and petals, bright pale yellow anthers and pale lemon interior of the hypanthium. The vernacular name (= monk's crown) refers to the circular abcission scar at the top of the fruit.
