*Anadenanthera peregrina* (L.) Speg.  
Vernacular name: Angico preto

Fazenda Furninha, 12km from Rondonópolis  
(16°29'S 54°37'W) on the Cuiabá road.  
On a slightly raised mound covered in  
cerrado vegetation, surrounded by  
hydrologic campo ('campo com moitas', ie a  
vegetation type coming close to 'campo de  
murundum').

Small spreading tree, 5m tall, 12cm dbh.  
Bark beginning to show the irregular ±  
Giant's Causeway pattern typical of Angico  
preto. Flowers creamy white.
