Cyclolobium *clausenii* Benth.

Rio Parida (14°07'S 47°13'W), 31.5km from Alto Paraíso de Goiás on the road to Nova Roma.

In mesophytic gallery forest on the steep bank of the Rio Parida. In a community of trees of more fertile soils, e.g. *Astronium urundeuva*. Quite a dry habitat for most of the year.

Tree, 10m tall. Branching into many trunks almost from the base. Thickest trunk 60cm dbh. Bark fissured into squares exactly like that of *Callisthene fasciculata* (Vochysiaceae).

Another tree of *Cyclolobium* (R.7432) is growing 60m away but has very different bark.
