Cyclolobium Claussenii Bent.

Rio Parida (14 $^{\circ}$ 07'S 47 $^{\circ}$ 13'W), 31.5km from Alto Paraíso de Goiás on the road to Nova Roma.

In mesophytic forest of richer soils about 60m from river.

Tree 18m tall, 75cm dbh, with deeply fissured, thick, corky pale fawn bark, detaching in irregular deep scales. R.7431 is another *Cyclolobium* about 60m distant but has completely different bark. Both trees are being attacked so heavily by caterpillars with narrow black and white longitudinal stripes that the frass is falling like light rain. Another nearby *Cyclolobium* with the same bark as this specimen has been completely defoliated by the caterpillars.

There are two similar specimens in the herbarium of UB: Heringer 11622 & 11960 both from the banks of the Rio Corumbá, Luziânia, Goiás.
