Erythroxylum cf. *anguifugum* Mart.

21km from Monte Santo on the road to Divinópolis,
9°53'S 49°08'W, alt. 250m.

On the edge of a clump of trees in a rather damp hollow with much *Curatella americana*. There is a buritizal nearby.

Tree, 8m tall, 30cm dbh, with bark forming a vertically elongated mesh network (like *Robinia pseudacacia*) but on a smaller scale). Fruiting copiously. Fruits scarlet and being eaten by parakeets.
