Stryphnodendron adstringens (Mart.) Coville Vernacular name: Barbatimão

44 km from Niquelândia on the road to Colinas do Sul, 14°26′S 48°08′W, alt. 480m.

In area of campo cerrado on soil covered in quartzitic pebbles.

Tree, 3.5m tall, 35cm dbh, with bark fissuring into small blocks. As usual with this species, the bark has been part stripped to make medicine. The tree looked somewhat unusual (according to the field note: 'the lvs look like *coriacea* but bark is  $\pm$  that of *adstringens*').
